STEP ONE:

Fill out the form below to request a code in order to redeem your free USA Cycling Junior Race License. The code will be unique to your league and good for one time use. A parent or guardian email is required.

STEP TWO:

Head to usacycling.org to sign up in a few minutes, and receive all the benefits listed below for FREE with your Junior Race License, using the code delivered to your email at checkout. The code is good for one use only.

- Domestic racing license (unlimited)
- Membership discounts from 200+ industry partners
- Access to talent identification camps and training programs
- Inclusion in national rankings platform
- VIP member perks at USA Cycling sanctioned events
- Birthday discount to the USA Cycling Online Store

Student-athletes have the option to purchase the Junior+ Membership, which will be discounted to \$50 at checkout, using the same code: All Junior Race License benefits listed above

- \$0 deductible, \$25,000 riding insurance (around the block, commutes, etc.)
- \$0 deductible, \$25,000 racing insurance at USA Cycling sanctioned events (learn more [HERE](#))

STEP THREE: (not required for free license and only necessary if you want to receive USAC points for your NICA races)

- **Intermediate** - Some trail riding experience. Basic MTB skills and some race experience. Comfortable and confident rolling over small obstacles (a couple inches high) like roots, rocks and small rollable drops (a couple inches high) - 1 to 3 years.
- **Advanced** - Considerable trail riding and/or race experience ; Very good bike skills. Ability to ride and race a variety of singletrack which may include tight trees, mud, loose rocks and sand and are comfortable doing so on aggressive terrain - 3 years +
